Needlepoint Belt Finishing Instructions

Belt Length

Measure a belt currently being worn from the tip of the buckle prong to the most used hole. This will give the finished belt size. If you cannot measure a belt, figure the belt size by adding 2" to the pant size.

Belt Width

Fourteen (14) mesh requires 22 rows of stitching.

Eighteen (18) mesh requires 28 rows of stitching.

-- Three rows on top and bottom will be turned to finish a belt.

Buckles:

Two types of buckles are available for finishing:

-- Regular Buckle (a plated buckle in gold or silver)

-- Solid Brass Buckle (gold or silver)

Leather:

-- Colors include:

-- Black

-- Dark brown

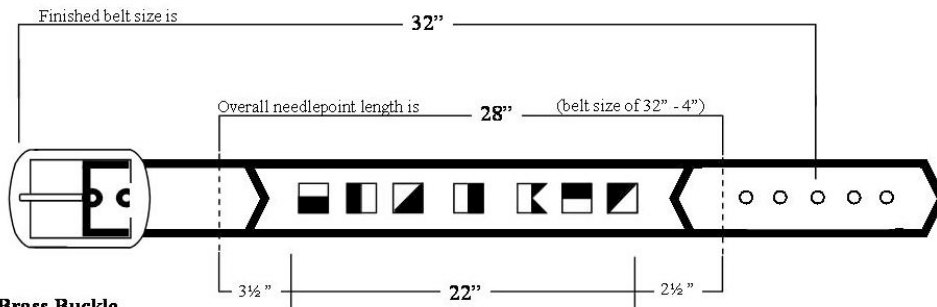
-- Wine
